## In Loving Memory

### The Marie A. Maduro Scholarship

For all who knew and loved Marie A. Maduro, July 4, 1994 will never be forgotten. It was on that day that Marie's life was tragically and needlessly ended.

We all know that with life comes death. It is an unavoidable fact. But violent death - especially of someone so young, so full of life and with such a bright future to come - shakes us all to the core and changes our lives in lots of little ways. Even as Marie lost her life and we lost her physical presence, something else was lost that day as well. Maybe it was our youthful innocence, maybe it was our naivety, maybe it was our trust in those who are supposed to protect and defend us.

Whatever it was that we lost, we will never completely lose Marie. She continues to live in our hearts and we keep her memory alive with the Marie A. Maduro Scholarship.

In June of this year, we were thrilled to be able to award \$500 scholarships to three very deserving young women- Latisha Weekes, Xenovia Farrell and Willis Pinney.

Each applicant had to submit an application with three letters of recommendation and an acceptance letter to a college or university with majors in medicine, science or social science. Each applicant also had to include a brief essay regarding his or her personal goals.

Initially the only two scholarships were going to be given, however after the selection process, one applicant made such an impression on the scholarship committee that a decision was made to award a third scholarship.

But, the scholarship committee is not satisfied with \$1500 in scholarships. We intend to double our scholarship amount this year and increase the amount every year after. Our goal is to give to the community that gave to us, to help those that are coming after us to and to give in loving memory of Marie.
